## Course Maintenance Update

As the temperatures have started to drop, we have started to see the bermuda grass go dormant. The roughs and fairways will soon be brown but we will continue to see some color on the greens and tees. These areas are being treated with light fertilizations that include some pigment in order to keep some of the color. We will be installing three pin placements per green and two will have caps put over them. This will allow us to rotate the pin positions without continually cutting cups in the greens. When the greens are not actively growing or have overseed on them, the old plugs can be unsightly and have a negative effect on the roll of the ball. On the putting green we will be eliminating all of the cups cut in the greens for the winter months. These will be replaced with target flags that push into the greens with just a metal spike.
